




Verb: A word that shows action or state of being. Unlike most of the other parts of speech, verbs change their form. The different forms of verbs show different meanings related to tense (past, present, future).

Irregular verbs are common verbs that do not follow the simple system of adding "d" or "ed" to the end of the word to form the past tense.
